

FIRE SAFETY

This guide is meant to provide you with some initial steps that can be taken to eliminate and reduce your risk of a potentially large fire claim.

01 ESCAPE PLANNING

- Do you have a fire safety plan in place?
- Is there a safe meeting spot outside of the building?
- Is someone in charge of making sure everyone got out safely?
- Have you practiced your escape plan at least twice a year?



02 SMOKE ALARMS



- Are there smoke alarms throughout your business?
- Have your smoke alarms been tested this month?
- If you have a fire sprinkler system when was the last time it was inspected?

03 Heating Appliances

- Have ALL wood burning appliances been properly cleaned and inspected by a professional?
- Do you keep portable heaters at least 3 feet away from loose drapes and furniture?
- Are all flammable liquids stored in approved containers, away from any heat sources?



04 Kitchen

- Do you keep combustibles (towels, loose clothing, oil spray bottles) away from any heating elements?
- Do you leave your cooking area unattended?
- Are your cooking surfaces kept clear of dirt & grease?



05 Electrical



- Have you replaced missing knockout fillers in your electrical panel?
- Have you replaced extension cords with permanent wiring?
- Has a risk inspector identified hotspots in your business using thermal cameras?
- Have you eliminated temporary heaters with permanent appliances installed by a licensed contractor.

06 General

- Are exhaust vents clear and free of obstructions?
- Are tools/appliances unplugged when not in use?
- Do you properly store chemicals in a designated space?
- Is all necessary storage kept away from sources of heat?
