

Risk Inspection Standards for Farm Operations focus on biosecurity as a top priority. Trillium ensures that its risk inspection protocols surpass industry standards to minimize exposure and transmission.

Technicians will follow any additional biosecurity measures specific to the operation, maintaining strict practices and adhering to farm-specific protocols provided by the insured.

1. GUIDELINES

- Risk Technicians will have no contact with livestock while on site.
- Technicians will not inspect more than one farm risk unless they are three days out of species.
- Risk Technicians travelling outside of Canada and coming into contact with farms or livestock will not inspect any Canadian farms for a period of one week upon return.

2. PROCEDURES

- All inspections are arranged by appointment.
- Technicians will not visit other facilities housing livestock on the day of an inspection unless agreed upon in advance by the insured.
- The insured and broker will be informed of all applicable biosecurity protocols prior to the risk inspection.
- Risk Technicians will not visit any farm where there is a known disease risk and will not enter any buildings without permission.

3. TRILLIUM VEHICLES WILL

- Be parked in an area designated by the insured.
- Be parked away from driveways, farm equipment, feed, and manure.
- Arrive clean and free of manure and organic matter prior to the inspection.
- Be cleaned after each visit and before the next inspection.



4. TRILLIUM RISK TECHNICIANS WILL

- Arrive personally clean with clean clothing, outerwear, boots, and appropriate PPE.
- Follow all reasonable biosecurity directives provided by the insured to prevent the spread of disease. Disposable items provided will remain onsite for disposal by the insured.
- Bring required PPE and technical equipment, including thermal cameras, tablets, coveralls, measuring devices, and electrical testing tools. All equipment is cleaned and sanitized prior to arrival.
- Secure footwear and clothing in a clean, sealed container following the inspection. Containers are disinfected between inspections.
- Ensure contaminated clothing is not worn into vehicles, and all footwear is washed using a Prevail solution.
- Clean and disinfect after each site visit, including the driver's floor mats and pedals.
